1. All exhibitors must familiarize themselves with all rules listed under Open Class General Rules, Section I.
2. **Entries**
 - a. Mailed entries must be postmarked by midnight on Sunday, July 7, 2019.
 - b. Mail entries to: RICO Fair, 4200 Archer Drive, East Moline, IL 61244.
 - c. On-line entries must be time-stamped by midnight on Sunday, July 7, 2019.
 - d. On-line entries may be made at www.rockislandfair.org
 - e. Exhibitors are not limited to the number of entries but may only collect 2 monies in any one lot number.
 - f. Entry tags will be sent by return mail.
3. **Check-In**
 - a. Exhibits may be brought to the fair Sunday, July 14, 2019 between 12:00 noon and 4:00 p.m., except for two-crust ed pies.
 - b. Whole pies are to be in place by 10:00 a.m. on Monday, July 15, 2019 and will be judged at that time.
4. **Judging**
 - a. Judging will commence promptly at 8:00 a.m., Monday, July 15, 2019.
 - b. All judging is open to the public.
 - c. All judge's decisions are final.
5. **Requirements**
 - a. Articles in this department must be the work of the exhibitor.
 - b. No article may appear in more than one entry number.
 - c. All entries must be in Ziploc bags with one plain white paper plate, or cardboard, underneath.
 - d. All entries must Not require refrigeration.
 - e. No commercial mix allowed except in convenience and decorated cake classes.
6. All unclaimed culinary exhibits will be disposed of at 9:00 p.m., Saturday, July 20, 2019. Tags and ribbons may be picked up at the Fair Office.
7. Exhibits will be released Saturday, July 20, 2019, between 8:00 and 9:00 p.m., or Sunday, July 21, between 8:00 a.m., and 12:00 noon.
8. *All premium checks will be released for pick-up after 3:00 p.m., Saturday, July 21, 2018. Checks may be picked up at the RICO Fair office, located in the Copeland Center. All checks must be cashed within 90 days from issue. A signature is required to receive premium monies. Checks not picked up will be mailed.*

CANNED PRODUCTS

1. Each jar should be labeled as to foods and processing method (either boiling water bath or pressure cooked).
 - a. All pickles must be processed in boiling water bath.
 - b. Green beans and tomatoes must be pressure cooked.
 - c. Jellies or jams should be processed in boiling water bath with standard two piece lids and top sealed.
 - d. **DO NOT USE PARAFFIN TO SEAL JELLIES OR JAMS.**
2. All jars must be approved canning jars.
3. Each jar in the exhibit, aside from the specific exhibits, should be different varieties of food.
